

# 25<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 8:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 28, 2018 CEDAR HILL RECREATION CENTRE

# MINUTES APPROVED by the membership at the 2019 AGM on November 20, 2019

## **ROUTINE BUSINESS:**

The meeting was called to order by Thomas Webber, VBDS President and Chair, at 8:01 p.m.

The Chair introduced Board members Liz Frick and Steve Montgomery, Office Administrator Christina Southern and acknowledged the contribution of VBDS member Bob Adams to the Board.

- 2. Adoption of the agenda

- 4. Business arising from the minutes
  - None.
- 5. Reports
  - a. Report of the President Thomas Webber
  - Thomas provided an overview of VBDS Board activities of the past year and acknowledged and thanked the volunteers who have assisted with VBDS activities.

- An update on the administrative staff assisting the Board was provided. Office Administrator, Christina Southern's contract has been renewed and the Board has acquired the services of Barbara Gordon as bookkeeper.
- Board member resignations were noted: Douglas Anderson (in September), Linda Ryder (in October) and Journey Hood (in November).
- Current VBDS membership is just over 225.
- Suggested areas for attention in the coming year include: music update, promotion of membership, class registration process, and establishment of a new finance and budget committee. Report attached.

## b. Report of the Treasurer - Thomas Webber

- Thomas advised he assumed the role of Treasurer after Linda Ryder resigned in October 2018 to volunteer in Tanzania for two years. Thomas provided an overview of the financial statement prepared by Linda and noted that although total revenue was down from the previous year, expenses were also down. A shortfall of approximately \$8,000 for 2017/18 was noted. (See attached report).
- Thomas advised that VBDS member Steve Hutchings had brought to his attention that some figures in the 2016/17 financial statement did not match figures in the 2017/18 comparison. Thomas advised that the differences are not that great, that the bottom line does not change and that the differences noted may be due to a re-grouping of numbers or to Excel formulas. Thomas indicated he would explore this.

# c. <u>Governance Committee Progress Report</u> – Liz Frick

• Liz provided an overview of the work of the Governance Committee and plans for the coming year. Governance Committee will continue its review of the VBDS bylaws for alignment with the new *Societies Act* and will consult, as needed, with VBDS members with expertise in this area. See report attached.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### 6. Resolutions

a. Ordinary Resolution #1: Setting annual membership dues for the VBDS (*submitted by the Board*)

#### MOTION:

BE IT RESOLVED that effective immediately, the annual dues for regular membership be set at \$70 per annum, and that the rate for eligible students and disabled persons be \$40 per annum, with the exception that members who are joining for the first time, or former members rejoining after an absence of more than 1 year from the expiration of their last membership year, may have their memberships pro-rated, such that if they join on or after March 1, the fee will be \$35 for regular members and \$30 for eligible students and disabled.

- It was noted that the fees are similar to last year but that the proposed motion provides for a pro-rated fee schedule with two intakes September 1 and March 1.
- It was noted that in the past, January has been a month with a large intake of new members. As increasing membership is a priority, it was suggested that having a prorated fee schedule with three intakes will help achieve this goal.

#### PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

• Amendment by Steve Montgomery: to continue with the pro-rated fee schedule with three intakes similar to the previous year.

#### AMENDED MOTION:

BE IT RESOLVED that effective immediately, the annual dues for regular membership be set at \$70 per annum, and that the rate for eligible students and disabled persons be \$40 per annum, with the exception that members who are joining for the first time, or former members rejoining after an absence of more than 1 year from the expiration of their last membership year, may have their memberships pro-rated, such that if they join after January 1 the fee will be \$50 for regular members and \$30 for eligible students and disabled, and if they join after April 1 the fee will be \$30 for regular members and for eligible students and disabled.

- It was noted that offering classes has always been the biggest form of recruitment for the club.
- It was suggested that information on class lists should be available earlier.
- It was suggested that the Membership Committee consider these suggestions and bring forward for discussion at the Board

  - Recognizing all of the volunteers who organize and coordinate the monthly dances including Dance Committee members Liz Frick (Chair), Cathy Hodson, Ildiko Fashoway, John Putters and Dale Morrisette; music volunteers Criena Henly, Journey Hood, Steve Montgomery and Neil Fleischmann; and Diane Duruisseau and Dave Killion who have expertly and enthusiastically led the line dances.
  - Special thanks to Vicky Killion for arranging the Chief and Petty Officer's Mess event in Esquimalt for the April 2018 dance and to Cora Constantino who has assisted at the door
  - For the coming year, dance dates for the next six months have been set and Dance Committee welcomes your input on themes for the New Year and ideas to make the dances engaging for all levels and members of the club.
- 2. Ongoing New for this Year:
  - Christina Southern's contract as Administrative Support renewed and extended for two years.
  - <u>Barbara Gordon</u> Book keeper
     Commenced Sept 1, 2018 recommended by and working with Linda Ryder (using SAGE Accounting Program). She is on contract up to 6 hours per month at \$40/ hour.

Journey Hood – November, 2018

We will be looking for at least <u>4 nominees</u> going into next year. We will need to fill the majority of the positions on the board; seeking a mix of both experienced and newer members.

Our bylaws state that the officers and one or more other persons shall comprise directors of the society. Our Bylaws state that the <u>minimum number of directors is 5</u>, although this year, but <u>six</u> is our recommendation.

Duties of the officers are outlined in the bylaws.

# 4. <u>Improvements Needed:</u>

- Marketing: Membership is down to about 225 (was over 400) as at November 14<sup>th</sup>,
   2018. We need to expand our efforts in this area via Website, Brochures, Demos lots of options and opportunities. Borrow from the successes of the recent past.
- <u>Music:</u> We have an annual budget for new fresh music and a review/upgrade of the music system and selection – work is underway thanks to Criena and Rob; others encouraged to get involved.
- <u>Finance & Budget Committee:</u> Not in place as yet going forward for 2018-19. Can use last years as an example (Doug, Linda and Thomas). Need a three person committee to review, recommend and report on this at least semi-annually. Keeps us on target and ensures better time and funds management. Makes recommendations and reports directly to the Board.
- <u>Class Registration Process:</u> turnout, small classes, and cancelations. Need a Committee to manage this at membership and class registration times. Helps to target problem areas, cancellations and managing hall and instructor costs.

#### **VBDS Governance Committee**

Report to the 2018 AGM of the Victoria Ballroom Dance Society 21 November 2018

#### PROGRESS REPORT

At the 2017 Annual General Meeting (AGM) last year, the Governance Committee recommended that Members approve a re-vamped Constitution and set of Bylaws, amended so as to meet the minimum requirements of a new *Societies Act* (under which VBDS is legally incorporated), and so as to take advantage of some of the new provisions allowed under the new *Act*. As part of this, the Committee recommended that VBDS should become a "Member Funded Society" under the *Act*, a new category of society created by passage of the *Act* in 2016.

At the AGM last year, several amendments to the Resolutions recommended by the Committee were discussed and approved. Subsequently, the new VBDS Constitution and Bylaws, as amended, was approved by Members, and have since been formally filed with the government registry, as required. The current Constitution and Bylaws are available on-line, on the VBDS website (via the drop-down, "About VBDS").

While the current Constitution and Bylaws (Revised as of 22 Nov 2017) meet the minimum requirements of the current *Societies Act*, there are a number of new provisions in that *Act* that may, in the long run, be of some value to our club, and may be in the overall interests of Members were they to be adopted. Some of these provisions, in the *Act* itself and in the *Regulations* since proclaimed under the *Act*, may allow for more flexibility and/or efficiency in conducting the business of the club.

The approach to this that the Committee has recommended to the Board is that we should continue to gradually and systematically review the new *Societies Act*, and its *Regulations*, on a regular basis over the next few years, to check for additional areas where the club might want to consider incrementally updating or revising our Bylaws (and perhaps other policies), in line with provisions and changes in the new *Act* and the Regs. This should proceed in careful consultation with Members or others with specialized interest in the field, to try to ensure that, on balance, the advantages of any proposed changes are expected to outweigh any disadvantages, at least over time.

Some examples of areas for possible further review (a number of which have come up in the past) would include (but are not necessarily limited to):

- (i) "notices" required for General Meetings (both timing & nature of notices, perhaps allowing for email notifications);
- (ii) explicit provisions re "signing authority" that might be incorporated in the Bylaws (in line with the "Model Bylaws" included in the *Regulations*);
- (iii) further improvement & clarity re "Conflict of Interest" policies and other Director/Board responsibilities;
- (iv) "categories of VBDS membership", including their various rights, benefits, & obligations (re Part 2, Bylaw Clause #4);
  - (v) securing greater clarity in the Bylaws on amendments allowable at our general meetings;
- (vi) securing greater clarity in the Bylaws on chairing general meetings of the society (in line with the "Model Bylaws" included in the Regulations);
- (vii) provisions & procedures for disciplining, sanctioning &/or removing Directors and Members, in line with provisions in the Act (especially re Part 2 of our Bylaws, Clauses #7 & 8);
- (viii) reviewing other provisions in the "Model Bylaws" that it may be in the long-term interest of VBDS to adopt (eg, changes to arrangements for "proxies".

Currently under review by the Committee are possible Special Resolutions that might be introduced at the 2019 AGM related to items (i) and (ii) listed above. Some potential wording for these amendments has now been circulated to several Members with background and expertise related to these two matters, who have worked closely with the Governance Committee in past years. Initial comments and suggested edits are being reviewed by the Committee, and the pros and cons of various options for change are being assessed. It is planned that these consultations will continue in the 2018-19 year, and that some detailed recommendations on these matters should be ready for consideration at the AGM in 2019.
